RESTRICTED USE AREA

follows: Commencing at the intersection of the southwestern boundary of Bradshaw Drive and the western boundary of the proposed drainage reserve on the western side of the Central Australia Railway; thence generally southerly along the said proposed drainage reserve boundary to its intersection with the 20 degree slopline on the northern slope of the Heavitree Range; thence generally west northwesterly along the said slopline to the prolongation southwesterly of the fenceline that approximately lies on a bearing of 207 degrees 59 minutes from the southern corner of Lot 3288; thence north northeasterly along the said prolongation and fenceline to the southwestern boundary of Bradshaw Drive; thence generally southeasterly along the said boundary to the point of commencement.
