

Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act DECLARATION OF RESTRICTED AREA

The Conservation Commission of the Northern Territory—

- (a) in pursuance of section 20B(2) of the *Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act* and a resolution of the Commission made on the eleventh day of February, 1983, being satisfied, on the recommendation of the Council, that the area of land described in the Schedule is subject to soil erosion through continued use of it by the public, declare that area of land to be a Restricted Use Area; and
- (b) in pursuance of section 20B(6) of the *Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act*, define the land to which the declaration referred to in paragraph (a) relates as that land demarcated on plan 82/1 which may be inspected at the Survey and Mapping Division, Department of Lands, Moonta House, Mitchell Street, Darwin and is displayed at the Darwin and Fred's Pass police stations.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT parcel of land being in the Hundred of Bray, County of Palmerston, Northern Territory of Australia, containing an area of 46.2 hectares or thereabouts; commencing at the northwestern corner of Wagait Tower

Road, thence generally in a westerly direction and being bounded on the south by the northern boundaries of lots 1 to 34 of plan LTO 62/3 thence south being bounded on the east by the western boundaries of lot 34 and part lot 35 of plan LTO 62/3 to a point on the northern boundary of section 6 thence westerly and generally southwesterly being bounded on the southern and southeastern boundary by the north and northwestern boundaries of section 6 to its intersection with the western boundary of the said section thence being bounded on its western boundary and heading generally northeast to a point being the intersection of high water mark and the prolongation of the western boundary of lot 34 of plan LTO 62/3 thence following high water mark along Imaluk Beach, Wagait Beach to a point where the prolongation of the most northeastern boundary of lot 28 of plan LTO 66/1 generally in a southeasterly direction to a point of intersection with high water mark, thence generally southwesterly to the intersection with the southern side of Road 20.12 metres wide thence bounded on the northwest by the southeastern boundary of lot 26 of plan LTO 62/4 to the southwestern corner of lot 28 of plan LTO 66/1 thence being bounded generally on the north and the west by the southern and eastern boundaries of the said lot thence being bounded generally on the southwest by the northeastern boundaries of lot 27 and 28 of plan LTO 66/1 and lots 1 to 25 of plan 62/4 to the northwestern corner of lot 25 of plan LTO 62/4 thence bounded by the northern boundaries of Wagait Tower Road, being generally northwesterly thence southwesterly to the point of commencement.

NOTE: Plan 82/1 may be inspected at the Darwin and Fred's Pass Police Stations and at the place indicated in this declaration and is at all reasonable times available for inspection without fee by members of the public.
